Further to my email earlier this week and given government policy changes I write to clarify our plans.

1. Primary Schools.

Plans remain as outlined on Tuesday 29th December.

January 4th INSET day. Closed to all pupils.

January 5th All primary schools reopen

2. St Mary's College

January 4th INSET day. Closed to all pupils.

January 5th Provision will be made onsite for children of critical workers and

vulnerable children. Guidance will be provided via the school

and the website.

Online live learning will commence for Years 11, 12, 13 and for

Y10 classes preparing for terminal assessments in 2021.

January 11th Y11 and 13 will return to onsite, direct teaching and

learning. Usual transport services will resume.

January 18th St Mary's College reopens for all students with onsite, direct

teaching and learning,

Years 7-9 and the other Y10 classes which are not subject to terminal assessment in 2021 will be provided with independent learning programmes as early as practicable from January 5. We will aim to move towards live online learning for them as soon as possible. Thank you all for your patience and support as ever. I am sorry about the uncertainties and wish it were otherwise. Needless to say, these plans may well change.
