Dear Parents and Carers,

I am writing to you to follow up from the letter I sent this morning from Julia Weldon, the Director on Public Health.

Having received notification of more than 1 positive COVID-19 case within the school community, I have carried out tougher risk assessments and sought further guidance and advice from the Public Health Team. This has led me to the difficult decision to cancel the live performances of the KS1 and Foundation Stage Nativity performances this week.

The children will still have the opportunity to performance them to a small audience of the school community which we will record and share on Google Classroom for your viewing. More details of this will follow in the coming days.

As I sure you can appreciate, this is not a decision I have taken lightly but the health and safety of all members of our school community, including children, staff and parents, is paramount.

It is hard to get the balance right between keeping people safe from COVID and making sure our children can have the best school experience possible but inviting people into school will increase risk and may result in people being poorly over the Christmas break. Something which I wish to avoid.

We hope that we can organise other events in the Spring term where we can invite you into school to showcase your children's fantastic work and share their learning with you.
